Top of 1st Inning, #4 Palmer Pitching

1. #5, Almonte - Ball, Ball, Ball, Ball.
2. #1, Boone – Strike, Ball (Almonte steals 2nd), Strike, Called strike 3
3. #3, Crisp – Foul, Foul, Ball (WP, Almonte takes 3rd), Foul, Foul, Ball, Sharp grounder to 3rd, Almonte holds at 3rd, Throw to 1st on-time but 1st baseman’s foot comes off the bag.
4. #6, Drysdale – Deep fly out to Center, Almonte tags and scores from 3rd, Crisp advances to 2nd on the throw.
5. #9, Escobar – Foul, Ball, Long line drive down left field line, just fair, rolls past the fence and out of play. Umpire signals Ground Rule Double.
6. #2, Freeman – Strike, Ball, Drag bunt to the left. Great play by pitcher gets him at 1st.

Bottom of 1st Inning, #6 Drysdale Pitching

- The Masters score one (1) run off of Drysdale.

Top of 2nd Inning, #4 Palmer still Pitching

1. #12, Green – Ball, Strike, Ball, Ball, Bunt to the left – Safe at 1st.
2. #13, Harvey – Ball, Bunt to the Right, Pitcher gets ball and throws Harvey out at 1st, Green advances to 2nd.
3. #8, Johnson – Strike, Ball, Ball, Bunt to the Left – Pitcher gets ball and throws Green out at 3rd. Johnson safe at 1st.
4. #4 Kiermaier – Ball, Ball, Strike, Strike, Foul, Ball. Kevin swings at next pitch, clipping the Catcher’s mitt. Umpire calls “Catcher Interference” and awards Kiermaier 1st forcing Johnson to 2nd.
5. Pitching change, #1 Zoeller for Palmer
6. #7, Luetge – Strike, Luetge hit on the leg by the next pitch, sent to 1st, loading the bases.
7. #5, Almonte – Strike, Strike, Foul, Ball, Foul, High fly ball to Left. With 2 outs, all runners are off with contact. LF settles under the ball trying to shield his eyes from the Noon sun. Ball glances off edge of his glove. Two runners score easily. The Luetge is waved home. Close play but ruled Safe. Batter/Almonte ends up on 3rd, in your judgment Almonte had 2nd easy but only took 3rd because of the play to the plate.
8. Pitching change, #3 Mickelson for Zoeller
9. #1, Boone – Ball, Strike, Line drive over 2B splitting RF & CF. Easy single (and Almonte scores). Boone rounds 1st and heads for 2nd as fielders chase the ball but has to swerve to avoid 1st baseman. Umpire calls “Obstruction” and play continues. RF runs down ball and guns to SS covering 2nd. He’s out. But Umpire awards him 2nd due to the Obstruction.
10. #3, Crisp – Ball, Strike, Ball. The 3rd pitch gets away from the catcher and Boone takes off for 3rd. Catcher pounces on the ball and snaps a bullet to 3B. Boone is out.

Bottom of 2nd Inning, #6 Drysdale still Pitching

- Defensive changes for the Big Boys
 - #7 Luetge replaces #4 Kiermaier in Right Field.
 - #13 Harvey replaces #8 Johnson in Left Field.
- The Masters score one (1) run off of Drysdale.

Top of 3rd Inning, #3 Mickelson still Pitching

1. #6, Drysdale – Ball, Strike, Line shot 1-Hopper slashing HARD just to the right of the SS, skipping just under his outstretched glove and into Left. Fielded cleanly by LF. Drysdale holds safely at 1st.
2. #9 Escobar takes his place in the box. The Master’s manager asks for time and tells the Ump “Drysdale batted out of turn.” The Ump checks with you and confirms the out-of-turn. Crisp is declared out and Drysdale is pulled off the bases, returning the dugout in bewilderment.
 - a. Warning, this is the one place where you will use an eraser. Transfer the count to crisp (so you can count the pitches against the pitcher) and erase Drysdale’s box. Yes, Drysdale loses his hit! It Never Happened!!
3. #9, Escobar – Ball, Strike, Strike, Line drive at shortstop who catches it in the air.
 - a. Easy mistake, but compounds one error with another – even if he gets away with it. BB mgr thinks Drysdale was out for batting out of order and proceeds to the next batter. Instead, it is Crisp who is out and Drysdale is the next.
4. {Inside Info: The Master’s manager sees that Escobar batted out of turn. However, he’s happy to accept the out rather than letting Escobar have another chance – so he says nothing.}
5. #2, Freeman – Ball, Ball, Strike, Foul, Foul, High pop fly in foul ground half way up the 1st base line. Pitcher, Catcher & 1B converge and bump into each other causing the ball to drop. Ball, High pop fly in the same place. Pitcher calls off everyone, dashes over and makes the catch.

Bottom of 3rd Inning, Pitching change, Leutge for Drysdale

- Defensive changes for the Big Boys
 - #4 Kiermaier replaces #7 Leutge in Right Field.
 - #7 Leutge replaces #6 Drysdale on the mound.
- The Masters score three (3) runs off of Leutge.

Top of 4th Inning, #3 Mickelson still Pitching

- #12, Green – Ball, Strike, Foul, Ball, Foul, Hits medium bouncer to 3rd. Ball takes long bounce and bounces off his glove. By the time he recovers the ball, Green is almost at 1st, but 3B throws to 1st anyway – wild, and the ball gets past the 1st baseman. Green ends up at 2nd. The fielder is a decent player.
- #13, Harvey – Strike, Strike, Hits medium grounder to Short. SS charges the ball, turns and prepares to throw to 3B to get the lead runner. He hears his coach yelling to throw it to 1st and pauses as it appears to take him a moment to realize what he is supposed to do. He then throws to 1st – too late. Green is safe at 3rd.
- #8, Johnson – Ball, Ball, Ball, 4th pitch is way inside and hits Johnson in the back (as he turns away from it).

- #4, Kiermaier – Ball, Strike, Strike, Ball, 5th pitch is high and inside. As Kevin tries to avoid it he fails to lower his bat and the ball bounces off it. Ball. 7th pitch is high but Kevin swings at it anyway. It moves unexpectedly and hits his hand as he swings and bounces toward the pitcher who throws to first. Kiermaier never leaves the plate, he is writhing in pain. All other runners advance a base on the play.
 - {Don't worry, The Umpire will call this so you won't need to.
It is a strike. The Hands are not part of the bat, so it is not a hit. He swung, so it cannot be a ball nor can he get the base due to HP. It's also a dead ball, because it "did" hit him, so all runners go back. (see Rules 6.05(e) and 6.08(b) Approved Ruling)
And, yes, it "IS" a painful way to strike out.}
 - {What if the Umpire calls it an HP and awards Kiermaier 1st???
YOU score it as the Umpire calls it. It's up to the manager to protest if he wishes.}
 - {What if the manager protests the game claiming the Umpire didn't apply the rule correctly???
YOU Record the exact state of the game when it was protested (#outs, which runners on which bases, time (if M-B) and note the protest in the score book.}
- #7, Leutge – Ball inside brushes Leutge's shirt. Umpire calls HP and awards him 1st.
- #5, Almonte – Strike, Strike, Ball, Hits sharp liner over second baseman's head, between the out fielders. Harvey & Johnson score easily. Letuge heads for 3rd. RF cuts off the ball and fires it to the cutoff man (2nd baseman) who fires to SS covering 2nd. Almonte, halfway to 2nd fears he won't make it and stops. SS and 1B get Almonte in a rundown and Leutge tries to score. SS throws home but Leutge is safe. Almonte ends up back at 1st.
- #1, Boone – Ball, Strike, Strike, Hits long drive to Power-Alley Left. It hits the top of the fence, bounces up, and comes down on the other side. Umpire (correctly) rules it a homer.
- #3, Crisp – Ball, Ball, Bunts to the right side. 1B charges, Pitcher heads for the ball and gets it, 2B fails to cover 1st. Crisp safe at 1st.
- #6, Drysdale – Strike, Strike, Ball, 4th pitch is wide and the catcher can't stop it. It bounces off to the side so far that Crisp not only takes 2nd but tries for 3rd. Catcher makes a long throw but Crisp slides under the tag. Ball, Ball for a walk.
- #9, Escobar – Strike, Drysdale heads for 2nd. The catcher ignores him and throws back to the pitcher. Ball, Slow bouncer to Short. SS charges and tries to get Coco Crisp going home, but not in time. Drysdale to 3rd. Escobar is safe but, in your judgment, could have been thrown out if the play had gone to 1st.
- #2, Freeman – Strike, Escobar heads for 2nd. Catcher throws to SS covering 2nd, in time, but the SS lets the ball bounce off his glove and Escobar heads to 3rd. Drysdale runs on the throw and scores. Ball, Ball, Ball, Ball.
- #12, Green – Hits sharp grounder to Short. SS throws to 2B for the out at 2nd and on to 1st to get Green.

Bottom of 4th Inning, Pitching change, Johnson for Leutge

- Defensive changes for the Big Boys
 - #8 Johnson replaces #7 Leutge on the mound.
 - #7 Leutge to Second for #5 Almonte.
 - #6 Drysdale to Center Field for #3 Crisp.
- The Masters score four (4) runs off of Johnson.

Top of 5th Inning, Pitching change, #6 Nicklaus Pitching

- #13, Harvey – Strike, Ball, Line shot to the fence in Right. Harvey ends up at 2nd
- #8, Johnson – Strike, Strike, on 3rd pitch Johnson swings and hits the catcher's mitt. The ball bloop Fair just beyond the 3rd baseman. Johnson is safe and Harvey, uncertain if it will be caught, holds at 2nd. The BigBoy's manager advises the Ump of his decision to accept the play per 6.08(d), rather than take the CI.
 - {Why? Either way, runners are on 1st & 2nd. This way Johnson gets credited with a hit which is better for his stats.}
- #4, Kiermaier – Ball, Pop fly fair to 1st baseman. Umpire calls "Infield Fly, Batter's Out". Harvey is 15' off 2nd when 1B catches the pop and throws to SS covering 2nd to double-up Harvey.
- #7, Luetge – Ball, Ball, Line drive to the Right side hits Johnson. Johnson called out. {10.05(e)}

Bottom of Top of 5th Inning, Pitching Change, Harvey for Johnson

- Defensive changes for the Big Boys
 - #5 Almonte to Short for #9 Escobar.
 - #3 Crisp to Center Field for #6 Drysdale who moves to Third Base for #12 Green.
 - #13 Harvey and #8 swap positions (Johnson to Left & Harvey to the mound).
- The Masters score four (4) runs off of Harvey.

Top of 6th Inning, Pitching change, #2 Nelson Pitching

- #5, Almonte – Strike, Strike, Hits hard line drive into Left and rounds 1st looking for chance to advance. LF fires to SS who sees Almonte is too far off 1st and throws to 1B. Almonte retreats toward 2nd and gets in a rundown. 1B throws to 2B who throws back to 1B to apply the tag. He's out.
- #1, Boone – 1st pitch swinging, lines a clean single to Right.
- #3, Crisp – Strike, Strike, Medium bouncer to 2nd baseman. 2B charging the ball, gets in the way of Boone who accidentally collides with 2B before he can field the batted ball. The ball rolls into shallow Right. Umpire calls Boone out for Interference Crisp placed on 1st.
- #6, Drysdale – 1st pitch swinging, grounds to 1st baseman who touches 1B for the out.

Bottom of 6th Inning, Harvey Pitching

- Defensive changes for the Big Boys
 - #9 Escobar to Short for #5 Almonte who goes to Second Base for #7 Luetge.
 - #12 Green to Third Base for #6 Drysdale who moves to First Base for #2 Freeman.
- The Masters score four (2) runs off of Harvey to complete their thrilling comeback and win the game 15-14.
