## Managers and Coaches

In an effort to keep everyone on the same page and make sure each team has the same amount of time to prepare for the game – **ALL-Managers/Coaches** - PLEASE adopt and follow this protocol as it allows both teams am equal amount of time for warm-ups and most importantly, keeps the players safe before the game.

**SAFETY** – All players MUST wear helmets when participating in batting practice/drills, and/or when in close proximity to where bats are being used. Players catching/receiving baseballs next-to or in close proximity to a Manager/Coach hitting baseballs to players MUST wear a catcher's helmet, mask, and throat guard.

From 1 hour before game-time up to 30 minutes before game-time: Both teams warm up in the <u>outfield</u>. No infield allowed. This time is for field prep.

**30 minutes before game-time:** <u>Visiting Team</u> takes the infield first and is allowed 10 full minutes. During this time, the <u>Home team must vacate</u> the **entire** field and return to their dugout to get equipment ready for Umpire inspection.

**20 minutes before game-time:** <u>Home Team</u> takes the infield second and is allowed 10 full minutes. During this time, the <u>Visitors must vacate</u> the **entire** field and return to their dugout to get equipment ready for Umpire inspection.

Aprox. 10 minutes before game-time: Both teams in dugouts. Plate Umpire conducts the manager meeting at home plate.

Aprox. 5 minutes before game-time: Teams take the lines and honor/recite the little league pledge.

Aprox. 2 minutes before the game: Pledge ends and Home team takes the field.

Game-time: The first pitch is delivered.

## <u>Question</u>: What about extra dads/coaches/parents/volunteers on the field before the game helping get the field ready?

## Answer:

- 1. ONLY 3-total coaches (1 manager and 2 coaches) are allowed to prepare the players for the game (whiffle-balls, infield, soft-toss, etc).
- 2. PALL encourages all Dads/Parents/Volunteers to help on the field with field-preparation <u>before</u> and <u>after</u> every game <u>as long as they are helping to get the fields ready to play</u>.
- 3. **Managers & Coaches** should ensure that these extra Volunteers DO NOT assist with getting the players ready when they are done preparing the field.

T-Ball and Rookies – PALL encourage lots of helpers in these non-competitive divisions.

T-Ball and Rookies Managers – Obviously you don't have umpires so use this as a guide to help ensure your games start on-time and to maximize playing time for the kids.

## All Managers & Coaches:

At the conclusion of EVERY Game – <u>PLEASE</u> ensure the mound & batters-box areas are raked (holes filled in) and those main areas as well as the entire infield are watered adequately.
